


# Colours are the Smiles of Nature '

Locateted in Golaghat district ,Assam, Deopahar is famous for its ruins that are centuries old. The ancient ruins and monument attract people from near and far and is a great site to see. This spot is located very close to the Numaligarh Refinary Limited and close to the Kaziranga National Park As well. It is known that this site was a part of the Kingdom of Jarasanda in ancient Assam also known as Jarasanda Nagar. The intricate architectural style of the Deopahar stone temple is indicative of the fact that it belongs to the period somewhere between 10th and 11th century. The Deopahar temple was the temple of Shiva. The Shiva Linga from the temple was shifted and the Babathan, Numaligarh temple was established in the 19th century near the Deopahar Hillock.









### AN EDUCATIONAL TOUR REPORT.
