## AN EDUCATIONAL TOUR REPORT.

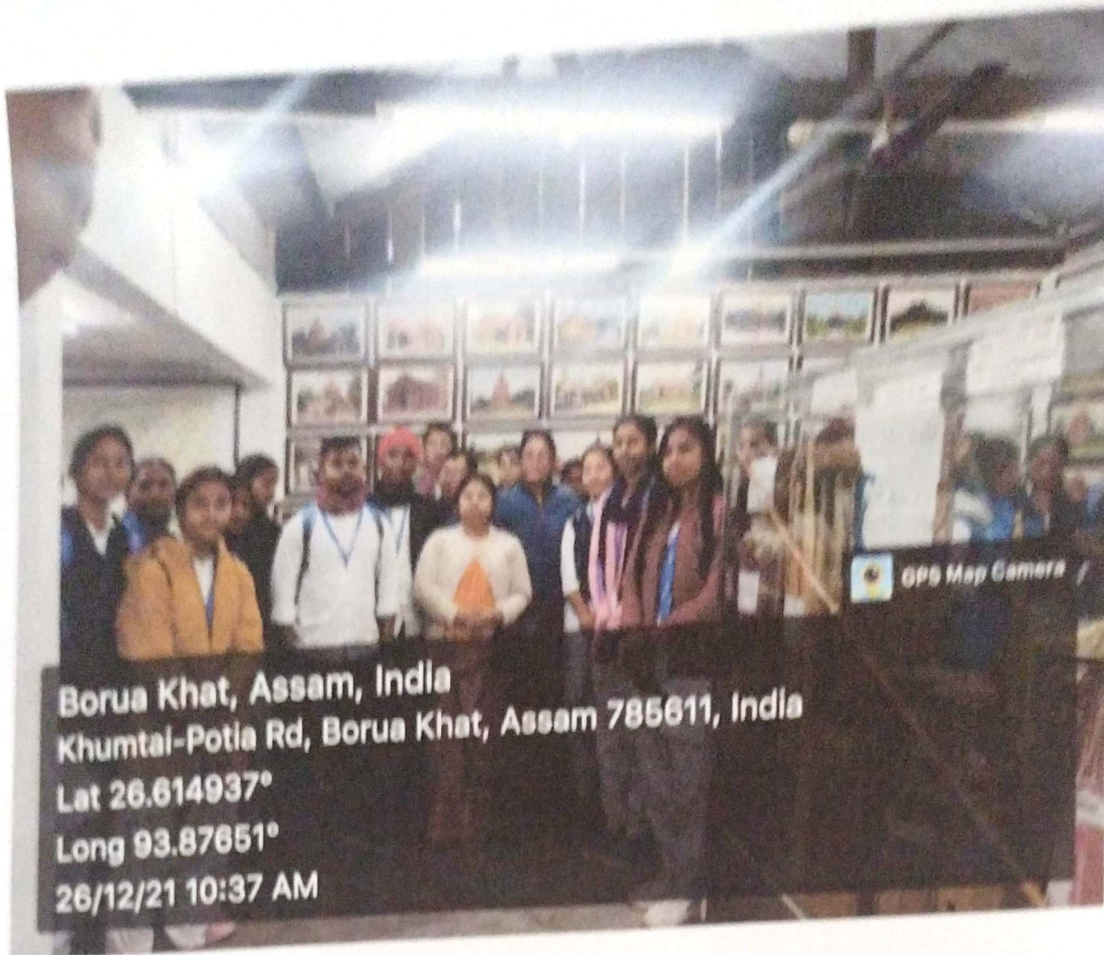
